Persecuted Church: Mali - is a poor country with a growing population that remains predominantly Muslim. 88 % of Malians are Sunni Muslims, with most also practicing animism. 3% are Christians. Although missionaries arrived in the early 1920s and have worked in most areas of the country, there are few Christians. Small congregations of believers continue to worship in towns known to be centers of Islamist activity. Several missionaries have been kidnapped in Mali or have been kidnapped and brought to Mali from neighboring countries in recent years. Some are still in captivity today. Threats by Islamist groups have led some mission agencies to withdraw workers from the country. persecution.com
