#### 10 Way to Pray

1. Pray that persecuted believers  
will sense God's presence (Heb.  
13:5).
  2. Pray that they will feel  
connected to the greater body of  
Christ (1 Cor. 12:20, 26).
  3. Pray that they will experience  
God's comfort when their family  
members are killed, injured or  
imprisoned for their witness (2  
Cor. 1:3-5).
  4. Pray that they will have more  
opportunities to share the gospel  
(Col 4:3).
  5. Pray for their boldness to make  
Christ known (Phil. 1:14).
  6. Pray that they will forgive  
and love their persecutors (Matt.  
5:44).
