**Persecuted Church: Afghanistan**  
- Sadly, most Afghans have never heard the gospel, do not know a Christian and have been indoctrinated to follow Muhammad's teachings without question. Afghan Christians cannot worship openly and evangelism is forbidden. Beatings, torture and kidnappings are routine for Christians. A small number of Christians are martyred every year in Afghanistan, but their deaths generally occur without public knowledge. Radical Islam and violent tribal political activity make the nation a difficult and dangerous place for Christians to practice their faith. There is, nevertheless, a special unity among Christians laboring for the gospel in Afghanistan. While church growth has been slow among the more than 40 unique people groups, significant Christian growth has occurred among the Hazara people, and members of other people groups are also coming to know Christ.

- Pray that Bible translation work will make God's Word accessible to Afghanistan's more than 40 people groups.
- Pray for Christians who have remained in the country and face extreme persecution from the ruling Taliban.
- Pray that many Afghans will hear the gospel through social media and broadcast sources.
